



ParentConnection

A new way for a parent to stay informed

Zangle's ParentConnection is a web application that provides parents with direct access to student data via the Internet. Using a confidential PIN (personal identification number) and password, parents can connect to the school district's student database using a web browser and view their child's data, such as progress reports, attendance records, report cards, transcripts, and more. ParentConnection allows the parent to view, in one session, data on all their enrolled dependents in the same district, across multiple school sites.

Explanation of Student Data Links

News – News items are bulletins or announcements for parents from school administrators and teachers. School News items are normally posted by school administrators, Classroom News are associated with the current student's classes and are posted by the teacher, District News are announcements and bulletins pertaining to the school district as a whole.

Demographics - Demographic screen shows essential information for the selected students, such as name, address, phone, etc. This is available so parents can check the accuracy of the information, as it exists in the school database.

Schedule – This page displays the selected student's daily schedule for the current and future terms. There are two viewing modes: Order by Period or Order by Term.

Attendance – Displays a record of attendance entries for the selected student in the current school year. An attendance entry is an attendance code entered into the computer system by a teacher or attendance clerk at the school site. A Summary of Attendance Reason table displays at the top of the page displaying the cumulative counts-to-date for each type of attendance code entered. An Attendance Detail table displays attendance data in descending chronological order.

Assignments - Assignments are scored classroom task assigned to students, such as homework, quizzes, exams, etc. When a teacher uses Zangle Gradebook to define, organize and score their class assignments, the assignment data for their students will be viewable to parents. Viewable assignment data include name of assignment, date due, and points possible, score and scored as. Note: a teacher has the option not to publish their Assignment information in ParentConnect. Two viewing modes exists Show Assignments for Last/Next Week and Show All Assignments.

Course Requests – The request screen displays all current course requests in the school's database for the selected student. Course Requests are used by the school to create schedules for the student. The screen simply shows what course request are current in the system it does not indicate which course requests were successfully scheduled.

Marks – This screen will display an aggregate list of all the report card marks that have been posted to the system for the selected student in the current school year. Mark reporting terms are represented by term codes in the subheadings, such as S1 for semester 1, S2 for semester 2 and so on.

Standards - Standards & Benchmarks system are used to define various levels of competence at each grade level and, through a benchmark system, gauge the degree to which a student has met the content standards.

Transcript – This screen displays the complete history of marks and credits earned for the selected student, since the beginning of their high school enrollment. The Mark column shows the final grade earned for a course. The credit column shows the credits awarded towards graduation for completion of the course. There are two viewing modes Show All Transcript Records or Show current School Transcript Records.

GPA – This page profiles the complete history of the student's grade point average for each mark reporting term, including their class rank and class size. The cumulative grade point average is also shown as each term is reported. There are two viewing modes Show All GPA Records or Show Current School GPA Records.

Graduation Requirements – Graduation Requirements are credits that must be earned per Subject Category in order for a student to graduate from high school. School administrators according to the district policy define the requirements.

Testing – This data set displays the student's score history in standardized testing. There are several data fields in Testing including; Subtest which are categories for a test, Score Types which is the scoring method defined to the test and the Pass and Score columns which display test results. There are two viewing modes Show All Test Records or Show Current School Test Records.

Behavior – When student conduct is tracked by school administrators using the Zang!e's Behavior database, behavior incidents involving the selected student can be displayed in summary form on the this screen. Behavior incidents are listed in reverse chronological order. Incident are not limited to the current school year; all related behavior incidents from the beginning of the student's enrollment in the district can be display in the Show All mode or you can view Show Current year Behavior for just the current year.
